## Letter of Recommendation

To assist in writing such a recommendation and avoid your recommendation sounding like a "form letter, please consider the following questions. Try answering several of them and giving the questions and your answers along with your request.

- 1. What courses or classes did you most enjoy? Why?
- 2. What course or class was the most difficult? Why?
- 3. What are your academic/career goals?
- 4. What books have you read for pleasure in the last year? Why did you enjoy them?
- 5. What is your best high school experience? Your worst?
- 6. What extra curricular activities do you enjoy? (clubs/sports)
- 7. What do you do in your spare time? (hobbies/interests/jobs)
- 8. Where have you traveled? What did you enjoy most about the experience?
- 9. What are your strengths and weaknesses?
- 10. Do your grades or rank accurately reflect your potential and abilities? Why or why not?
