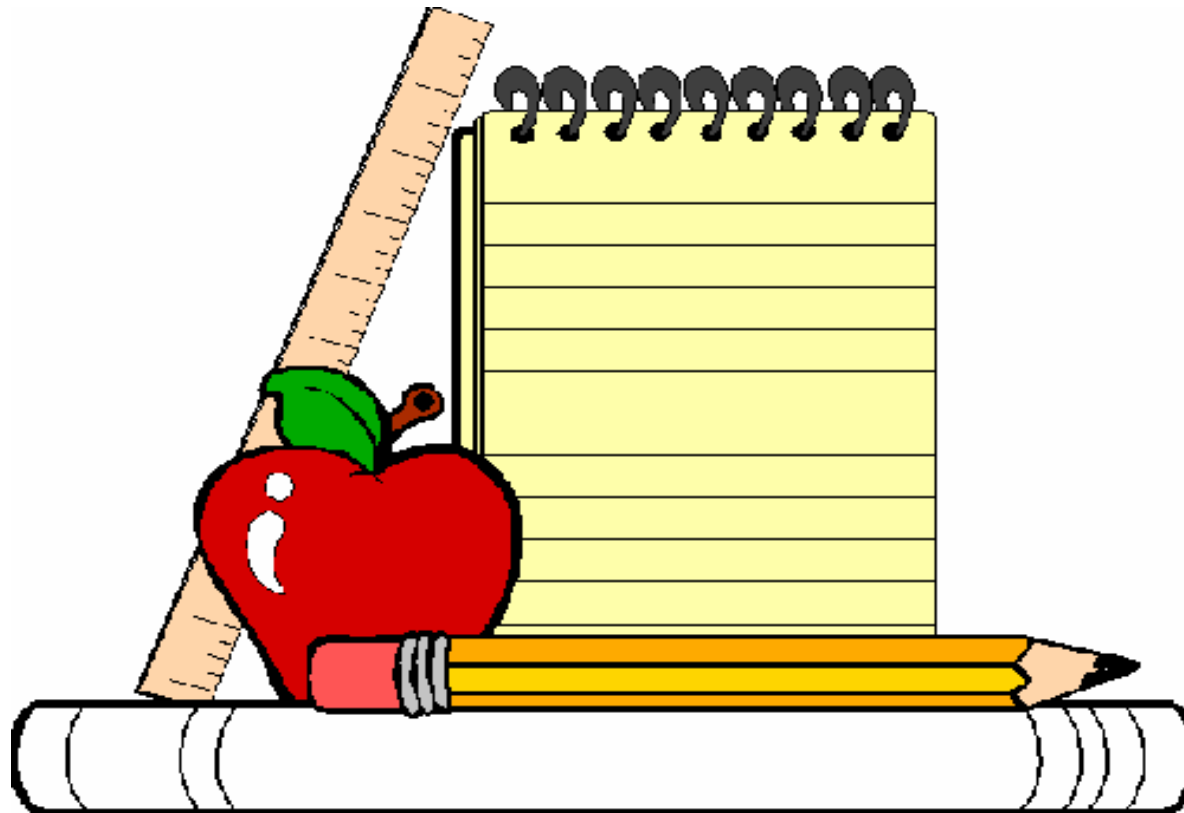


The Reading-Writing Connection
